1) **Policy and regulatory issues:**

- Establishment of a continental regulatory association.

2) Financing and investment:

- Collaborate with development finance institutions in Africa and bilateral donors in setting up financial mechanisms to meet the costs of initiatives undertaken by other multilateral bodies, namely: G8 DOT Force and the United Nations ICT Task Force.
- Establishment of a public private sector collaboration.

3) Infrastructure development:

- Prepare all African countries to use electronic communications and provide assistance towards introduction of digital technologies for broadcasting links.
- Reduce costs and improve reliability of services.
